APPLICATION PROCESS FOR INCOMING STUDENTS

(sms - student mobility for studies) :

1. Prepare your Application:

The following documents must be uploaded:

- Study plan (please refer to point 3.)
- Transcript of Records
- Curriculum Vitae/Resumé
- Letter of Motivation
- Copy of passport or identification card

2. Audition repertoire & Recording

The recording must be a video recording, uploaded to YouTube.

- **CLASSIC** : 2-3 musical extracts of your choice of different style/period (do not exceed 15 min.)
